

Desert Driver Training



The course syllabus covers the following subjects:

- Review of Defensive Driving techniques as necessary
- Additional maintenance and safety checks
- Use of AWD, differential locks and specialist gearboxes
- Ascent and descent procedure
- Driving in sand, mud and water
- Recovery techniques
- Survival techniques as required
- Vision scanning techniques

As the name suggests, desert driving covers all aspects of off-road vehicle operation on terrain varying from loose surface, graded roads to serious sand dunes. This training can be carried out for HGV driving also.

The course duration is one day and involves a comprehensive classroom session using video and other media, followed by a practical session in appropriate conditions using a suitably equipped 4x4 vehicle. The normal student to instructor ratio is 3:1 and assumes the availability of suitable vehicles.

Upon completion of the training a comprehensive report will be produced, plus an individual assessment form for each trainee and a certificate for each successful candidate.
